On Wednesday, March 6, we will begin the season of Lent with the observance of Ash Wednesday. One can spend a lot of time researching the origins of Lent and, in particular, the imposition of ashes on one's forehead as the penitent comes forward and the pastor takes the ashes on the end of his thumb, and makes the sign of the cross on the forehead of each worshiper, saying these words: "Remember: you are dust, and to dust you shall return." And while for many Christian congregations, (including ours) the imposition of ashes is not a part of their tradition, the special midweek services, the hymns that are sung, and the Scripture readings during worship all point to one thing: "God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8)."

The reality of personal sin is a fact that we all know too well. We can all agree with the confession, "I, a poor, miserable sinner confess unto You all my sins and iniquities." But what is also all too real is the fact that we live in a world terribly affected by sin, and filled with sinners just like us, many of which have no concern about it. And for those of us who do care, who strive to live a morally upright life out of love for our Savior, it is sometimes confusing when we see evil seeming to win out over good.

During our special Wednesday vespers services during Lent, we will focus on the book of Job, and his struggle with that very dilemma. We'll begin with seeing him grieving in ashes, hear him wish he had never been born, commiserate with him as friends seem to always condemn rather than build up, and ask with him, "What's the use?" But in the midst of it all will be the cry of faith and hope in a God who would also be a Redeemer.

Join us on Wednesday evenings during Lent for food for the soul at 6:30 p.m., as well as food for the body with special Lenten suppers at 5:15 p.m. (Thanks to Laurie Ellenson for organizing these meals). And as these Wednesday services are designed to be in addition to Sunday worship (Sundays are not included in the 40 days of Lent), be sure to gather again on Sunday to begin each week with worship. (*Please note: during the season of Lent we will not have Thursday evening worship services.*)

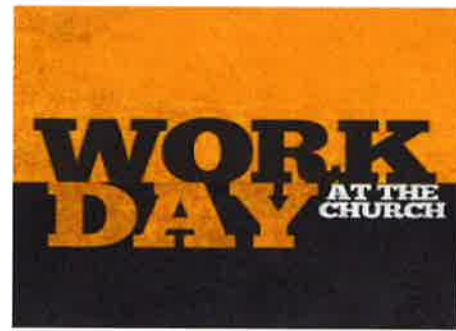

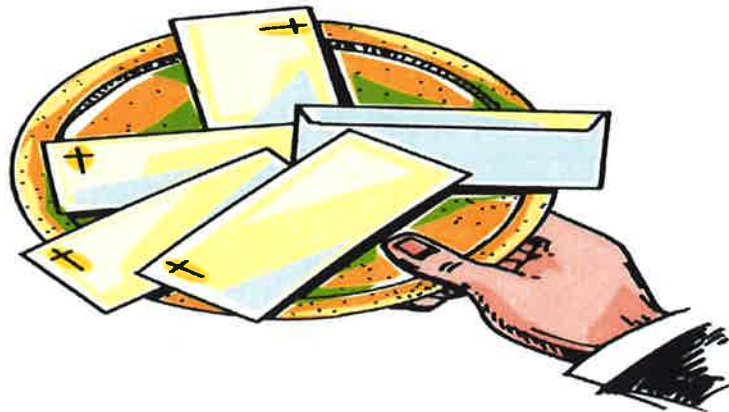
SCRIP DATES FOR MARCH

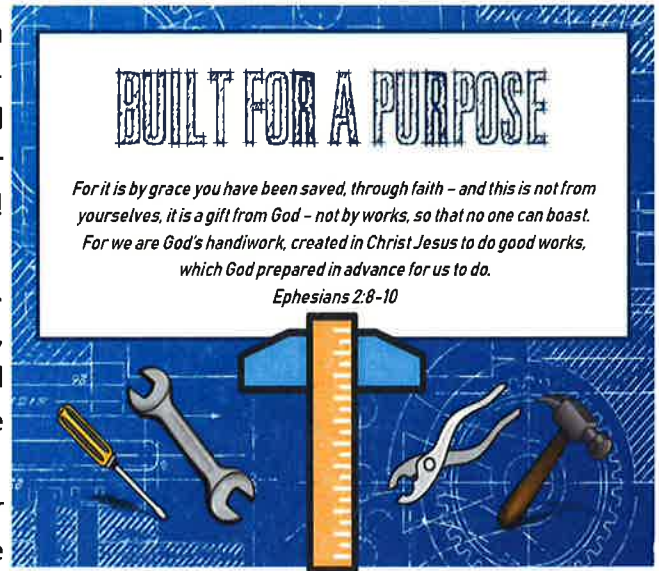
